*Then was Yahusha led up of the Ruach into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil. 2 And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward hungry. 3 And when the tempter came to him, he said: If you be the Son of Elohiym, **command that these stones be made bread.** 4 But he answered and said: It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of Yahuah.*

29 Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. 30 Therefore being a prophet and knowing that Elohiym had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Mashiach to sit on his throne; 31 He, seeing this before spoke of the resurrection of Mashiach, that his soul was not left in She'ol, neither his flesh did see corruption. 32 This Yahusha has Elohiym raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

36 Therefore let all the house of Yashar'el know assuredly, that Elohiym has made that same Yahusha, whom ye have crucified, both Adonai and Mashiach.

9 Wherefore Elohiym also has highly exalted him and given him a name which is above every name: 10 That at the name of Yahusha every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11 And that every tongue should confess that Yahuah is Yahusha Ha'Mashiach, to the glory of Elohiym the Father. 12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. 13 For it is Elohiym which works in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

What is it which these witness against you? 63 But Yahusha held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him: I adjure you by the living El, that you tell us whether you be Ha'Mashiach, the Son of Elohiym. 64 Yahusha said unto him: You have said it. Nevertheless, I say unto you: Hereafter shall ye see the Son of A'dam sitting on the right hand of power and coming in the clouds of heaven.

7 Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be baptized of him, O offspring of vipers, who has warned you to flee from the wrath to come? 8 Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance and begin not to say within yourselves: We have Avraham to our father: for I say unto you: That Elohiym is able of these stones to raise up children unto Avraham.

Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speaking, 2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 3 If so be ye have tasted that Yahuah is gracious. 4 To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of Elohiym, and precious, 5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to Elohiym by Yahusha Ha'Mashiach.

*6 Wherefore also it is contained in the Scripture, Behold, I lay in Tsiyon a **chief corner stone**, elect, precious: and he that believes on him shall not be confounded.*

7 Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, 8 And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

*17 Your eyes shall see the king in his beauty: they shall behold the land that is very far off. 18 Your heart shall meditate terror. Where is the scribe? Where is the receiver? Where is he who counted the towers? 19 You shall not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than you can perceive; of a foreign tongue, that you cannot understand. 20 **Look upon Tsiyon, the city of our solemnities: your eyes shall see Yerushalayim a quiet habitation, a Tabernacle that shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken.***

21 But there the glorious Yahuah will be unto us a place of broad rivers and streams; wherein shall go no galley with oars, neither shall gallant ship pass thereby. 22 For Yahuah is our Judge, Yahuah is our Torah giver, Yahuah is our King; he will save us. 23 Your tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast; they could not spread the sail: then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame takes the prey. 24 And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity.
